Project proposal	<p>Problem statement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A large number of primary and junior high school students are unable to read fluently. - Poor performance in the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE) and West African Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) due to lack of learning and research facilities in the community. <p>Project goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To provide access to reading, learning and research facilities in the community by 2012. - To improve the reading skills of students by 30% by 2016. - To raise the level of academic standard in the community so that by 2016 about 85% of junior high school leavers will get admission to senior high school.
